

# SECOND CENTURY BUILDING COMMITTEE

The Vision Board has converted the construction loan into a commercial loan with Merchants Bank. The Second Century Committee is happy to report that our project cost, loan amount, and monthly payment all came in less than was anticipated by the committee and approved by vote of the congregation.

The final numbers on the building project are as follows:

Total project cost \$1,071, 638.84 Budgeted cost \$1,082,460 \$10,821.16 under budget

Loan amount approved \$588,460 Actual loan amount \$561,269.76 \$27,190.24 less than approved

Monthly payment approved \$3500 Actual monthly payment \$3059.81 \$440.19 less than approved
