### **Actions since last meeting:**

## **Financial Report received**

We had a 2025 budget planning meeting on November 2, 2024. Jodi followed up on the few recommendations that we had and presented the updated proposed budget. Motion made and 2nd to approve the proposed 2025 budget to be presented at the annual meeting in February. Motion passed.

With the generosity of recent donations, we have been able to get our mortgage under \$200,000. THANK YOU!

No transfer of funds from Thrivent during October. Offering and rental income show a positive October income of \$999.51 after expenses.

December - ELCA Good Gifts program. This is an opportunity to give toward buying an animal, a hygiene kit, or stock a backpack with food in nations all over the world.
