#### **NEW BUSINESS**


- Granted a request from the Heller Family to celebrate a 50th Wedding Anniversary here at HCLC on July 12, 2025.

Versiti Blood Center is the sole blood supplier to all the hospital systems in the Coulee Region. This means that our donations go out to treat family, friends and community first. Each donation received ensures enough blood to meet tomorrow's needs. Its an ongoing cycle and ongoing need. Approximately 38% of people are eligible to donate blood, but only less than 5% do.

In one hour you can save 3 lives. The actual procedure of donating your blood takes about 10 minutes, but there is some preliminary screening and a little recovery time for refreshments afterward. Happy Easter! The weather will be warming up and the Halfway Creek Lutheran Church Cemetery welcomes you to visit and feel the spirit of your loved ones buried there. New life awaits all of us, share the Good News.

#### Matthew 28:5-8

The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you." So, the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples.

Please consider stepping up to help with the lawn care this summer. We have a family interested but more help will be greatly appreciated.

It's never too early to purchase your final resting place If you plan to be buried — or cremated and buried — in Halfway Creek Cemetery, it's to your benefit to choose your location and purchase your lot(s) well in advance of your demise. Halfway Creek Lutheran Church members pay just \$300 for a single casket-and-vault burial plot OR a cremation plot that will accommodate up to four cremation urns. Nonmembers who wish to be buried — or cremated and buried — at the cemetery pay \$600 for a single casket-and-vault burial plot OR a cremation plot that will accommodate up to four cremation urns. Nonmembers who wish to be buried — or cremated and buried — at the cemetery pay \$600 for a single casket-and-vault burial plot OR a cremation plot that will accommodate up to four cremation urns. Cremation urns may be buried in an existing family member's plot (a parent, grandparent, great-grandparent, aunt or uncle, for example) for \$250 per urn.
